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

Disk 2: V.L.E. Format

Disk 2 contains the PE Resource Bank packaged and ready for delivery via a Virtual Learning Environment. To add the Resource Bank to your V.L.E., load the disk into a suitable computer and then from your V.L.E., create a new SCORM resource, browse to the CD and select. The associated manifest file will recreate the same 16-block menu structure and search feature within the V.L.E. course.
